Cornell vs. Harvard

Preview: Unfortunately for us, Harvard is very good. They've got 11, count 'em, 11 NHL draft picks on their squad. They come into today's game atop the ECAC standings with a 6-0 record pending the result of Friday night's Colgate game at Hamilton. Although they have the personnel and the numbers behind them, they still must contend with the Lynah Faithful. So its **your** job to be loud, supportive, imaginative, and yes, even rude and obnoxious. Just please don't throw stuff on the ice; it shows lack of imagination, is dangerous to all the players, messes up the ice, and can lead to penalties being assessed to Cornell. You might say to yourself: "yeah, yeah, stop preaching", but three years ago Cornell was given two bench minors because of objects thrown on the ice, and it almost lost the game. The last thing we need against Harvard is to be a man short, so give us a home ice advantage, not a disadvantage today and keep the stuff off the ice. (Except, of course, The Chicken)

Players to Watch on the Crimson: Where do we start? Offensively, *Tim Barakett*(21), *Allen Bourbeau*(24), and *Lane MacDonald*(19), combined for 65 goals last season. Defensively, *Mark Benning*(4), (2g-36a) is an outstanding puck handler, *Randy Taylor*(15), is big and offensively skilled. *Jerry Pawloski*(20) is also solid. Finally, *Chris Biotti*(22), was hurt most of last year but is considered one of the best defensemen in the East, and was drafted in the first round by Calgary, the same year Joe Nieuwendyk was drafted in the second round. The list goes on and on, but you get the idea.

Players to Berate on Harvard: First, there's *Steve Armstrong*(27), who, being from Ithaca, showed no class in going to Harvard. Also, there's the goalie, *Dickie McEvoy*(1). Gotta love that preppie first name. We're sure you can think of a few more.
